Please submit your application via the Bar Staff or mail it to the above address (attention Membership Chair). Dues may be paid by cash, cheque, debit or credit card via the Bar Steward or by cheque if mailed to the Membership Chair - you will be issued a receipt and a membership card.

New applications are reviewed/approved by the Board of Directors.

Active or retired members of the Royal Canadian Artillery (RCA) (Gunners) may join as Active Members immediately. Non-RCA Military persons may apply for Active membership after 1 year (12 months) and others after two years (24 months), by completing the application form available at the Club.

Members & Associates may attend & speak at general meetings, Life & Active members may vote & hold office.

Members & Associates are exempt from the cover charges, receive a discount for most special ticketed events & on venue rentals. As well, through volunteering in the club, participating in the events, & your annual dues, you are contributing to the sustainability and future of the Association.
